Song of Songs 1:1-2v7

v1 *It is the greatest song ever written! By Solomon*

It's erotic not explicit

It's setting is a garden city - an Eden-like Jerusalem

It's about the Son of David, the New Adam - Jesus Christ - and his bride!

It's full of wisdom for human relationships

It's written for a confused world, full of sexual sin and brokenness, and offers a better story

1v2-7 She longs to marry and be intimate with the king, but
doesn't feel worthy

1v8-2v6 He assures her of his love for her, and she delights in it

2v7 This is a love worth waiting for
