Trained by Grace

Titus 2:11-3:15

Intro: Doesn't God's grace mean you can get away with anything?

Recap (2:11-14): God's gospel of grace both saves AND transforms

"Amazing grace, how sweet the sound, that ... a wretch like me"

1. As citizens/workers/neighbours in society, Christians should be:

(3:1-2)

- Submissive to authorities
- Eager to do good
- Gracious in speech
- Considerate to everyone

How?

2. By remembering the gospel of God's undeserved grace in Jesus

(3:3-7)

- Because we ourselves were...
- But God's saving grace appeared...
- Not by our doing, but by his mercy...
- Being washed & reborn by the Holy Spirit through Jesus...
- Declared righteous now with eternal life to come!

3. So church leaders must teach God's life-transforming gospel of grace and silence foolish nonsense

(3:8-15)
