Matthew 11 1-24

The Book Q: The Saviour-king is here, will YOU become a disciple who makes disciples? (Matt 28:18-20)

The Section Q: Is Jesus Christ really the king of the whole world, when people keep rejecting him?

- How can all these people be wrong.... is the evidence not actually that strong?

- How can all these people get away with rejecting Jesus... are there no real consequences?

To the bewildered believer in prison... v2-4

1. The evidence shows Jesus really is the promised Saviour-King of the World 4-6

· The deeds you see

(see Isaiah 35:5-6)

· The teaching you hear

(see Isaiah 61:1-2)

The nagging question: but what about the promised judgement?

To the crowds looking in...

2. John the Baptist shows Jesus really is God, the kingdom of heaven is here! 7-15

See Malachi 4:5-6

That nagging question: but what about the promised judgement?

3. So those who stubbornly refuse to listen to both John and Jesus... 16-19

...will certainly not get away with it ultimately 20-24

Conclusion:

Blessed are you? (v6) or Woe to you? (v20-24)

It all depends what you do with Jesus
