Message of Romans: confidence in the gospel and much more

The gospel in a nutshell (vv16-17)

The gospel destroys shame (v16a)

The gospel is a living supernatural power (v16b)

The gospel can save anyone (v16c)

The gospel saves only those who believe (v16c)

The gospel came to the Jew first, then the Gentile (v16d)

The gospel is the perfect righteousness of God revealed in Jesus (v17a)

The gospel is the perfect righteousness of God provided for us (v17a)

The gospel is the perfect righteousness of God given to us (v17a)

The gospel is received by faith permanently and exclusively (v17b)

The gospel, when received, results in a new way of life (v17b)
