## What can save humanity? The Meal

Luke 22:1-38

*Intro: making plans for Easter...*

### 1. There's more than one plan going on here... (22:1-13)

As leaders plan for an ambush...

As Satan plans to seize the moment...

As Judas plans for a betrayal...

### **The LORD has been planning for the true Passover!!**

*Q: How long has this been planned?!*

A: days...? 22:7-13

A: weeks...? 9:22; 9:44; 17:25; 18:31-33

*Q: What is Passover all about?*

A: People being rescued from God's judgement by the death of a substitute lamb (22:7) [Exodus 12]

### 2. Passover teaches: Jesus has to die for us to be right with God

(22:14-20)

- Jesus the servant is about to suffer v15
- Jesus the king is about to be crowned v16-18
- As Jesus the substitute enables a new covenant with God v19-20

### 3. We do need him to serve us given our selfishness, sin & failure

- Just one bad apple? v21-22
- All wanting to be kings, failing to serve v24-27
- Peter wanting to be loyal, failing to stand v31-33

*Conclusion: know for certain... the only access we have to God's eternal banquet (v30) is by the king being counted a criminal (v37)*
