Death Reigned

Genesis 5:1-6:8

Intro: "Like father, like son"

Before "Episode 3" (5:1-6:8), Genesis so far:

"Episode 1" (1:1-2:4):

The Sovereign God creates a very good creation for humanity to rule

"Episode 2" (2:5-4:26):

Humanity rebels, creation is spoiled & cursed, violence spreads

1. Humanity is fruitful, multiplying... ...and universally* mortal (5:1-32)

"You will surely die" (Genesis 2:17, ESV)

"...because of one man's trespass, death reigned" (Rom 5:17, ESV)

***But note the hope of a different end! (Enoch!) (5:21-24)**

2. Humanity is attractive, mighty... ...and universally wicked ...facing universal* judgement (6:1-8)

Every Only Continually

***But note the hope of a different end! (Noah!) 6:8, 5:29**

Conclusion: "We see him who for a little while was made lower than the angels, namely Jesus...so that by the grace of God he might taste death for everyone. (Heb 2:9 ESV)
